If you have completed a school card application or arranged a payment plan already, please disregard this notice.

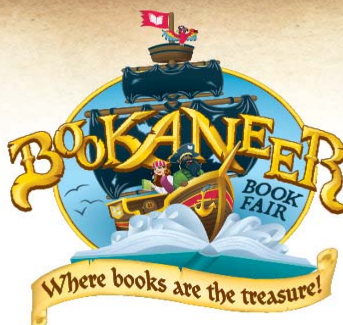
Scholastic Book Club News
