I would like to publicly recognise the fantastic work our school volunteers do across a wide range of areas, from listening to students read, to Breakfast Bellies, to Sports Coaches and to those who assist with fundraising events. The school's Mother's Day Stall is a good case, it raised approx. \$1350.00 and was enjoyed by students. I would like to thank the volunteers for serving and assisting our students while the stall was open and especially Erica James for her ordering of products and overseeing the stall's success. I would also like to thank all the parents that supported this fundraising event and a host of other fundraising activities held throughout the year.

Money raised through fundraising supports a number of activities at Braeview; Crash and Bash, excursions and facility upgrades, etc. Work is planned to have the school gym air conditioned and Governing Council are donating money to support this. Work should begin on this project later this term and be completed before summer arrives. This upgrade will enable all our gym related activities to be conducted in pleasant conditions.

The school has re-introduced a Reflection Room in response to on-going poor behaviour of many students across R-7. A number of students continue to demonstrate poor behavioural choices because there are few consequences for their behaviour. Students who attend the Reflection Room will bring home a note to be signed by their parent/caregiver and will continue to attend the Reflection Room until the note is returned. Students who attend the Reflection Room three times in a term will have a day's internal suspension and two internal suspensions will result in a day's external suspension. The Reflection Room will be supervised by Tracey Thomson and David King.

Student Reports will come home soon, they should focus upon the progress your child has made so far this year. Our mid-year reports are our detailed reports and teachers provide information across all learning areas as well as a general comment. If you need more information about your child's progress please contact his/her teacher and arrange a meeting. Meetings can be held anytime during the year. There should be nothing in a report that is a surprise to you if you have taken an interest in your child's learning.



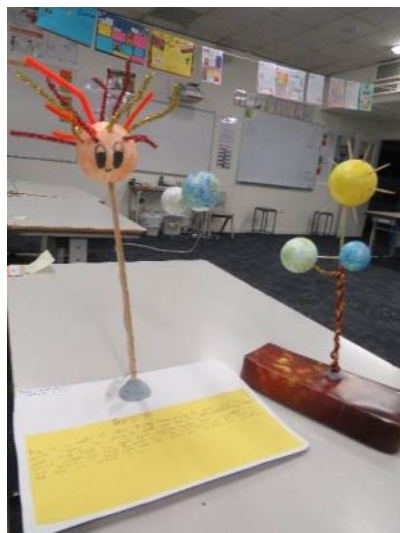
