Jasmine has already met with our aboriginal students and is planning opportunities for them to meet regularly. Our aboriginal students are really keen to meet together to celebrate their culture. Jasmine is also keen to work with our aboriginal students and presents as an energetic educator. Jasmine will be based at Aberfoyle High School and will work with all schools across our partnership.
