from the Principal's Desk

Braeview has had a rubbish audit carried out by KESAB earlier this term, the results are currently being discussed by SRC. One aspect was how much food is not being eaten but thrown into bins at lunch time. Students have 10 minutes to eat their lunch in class before the lunchtime siren sounds. It seems that many don't get through all their lunch so it goes into the bin on the way out to lunch. SRC believe this is the main reason behind food ending up in bins. Students want to play rather than eat. Another possible reason is that they may not like what they have for lunch so throw it away so they don't have to discuss it at home. Teachers will have students take home what is not eaten so parents are aware that they may be packing too much or foods their children prefer not to eat. It would be useful to discuss with your child if they like what they have for lunch and are they eating all of it? SRC are discussing this topic in classes and will continue to look into this and will come up with some possible suggestions as to how to improve this situation.

Governing Council has approved a Student Free Day for August 31st and a School Closure Day for September 3rd. The Student Free Day will be used by three schools, Thiele PS, Flagstaff Hill PS and Braeview School to focus upon how teachers differentiate the teaching and learning programme. Differentiation is how teachers plan units of work around ensuring that all their students are challenged; students that need support, students that find the work at their level and students who find the work easy. Along with this will be the expectations that are placed upon all their students and how they provide feedback to students throughout the work. It will be valuable to share this work with teachers from other schools so our teachers are exposed to other strategies and planning processes to differentiate teaching.

Out of School Hours Care will be available to care for students for the Student Free Day, Friday 31st August, but will be closed on the School Closure Day. 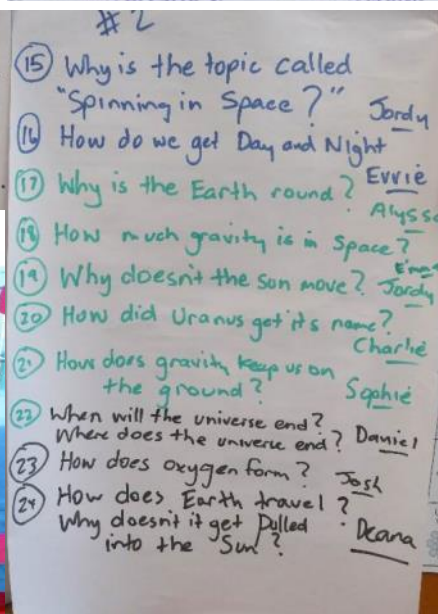
