### *from the Principal's Desk*

I would like to welcome Judy Beal to Braeview. Judy is the successful applicant for our leadership role in teaching and learning and STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics). This role is for 5 years and Judy is a welcome addition to our leadership team.

Judy's role will be a combination of teaching (Monday to Wednesday) and then joining Tracey Thomson and I (Thursday and Friday) in planning and facilitating the work with staff around our site priorities. Judy will be sharing a Year 4/5 class with Anne Burgess and she brings a wealth of experience across a variety of schools and roles to this position.

With a staff of nearly 50 people we have known that another person in leadership is essential in being able to work with all staff and their learning communities. Tracey, Judy and I will lead and facilitate the work these learning communities are focusing on, currently this is planning and designing English and Maths ensuring that all students are catered for and are challenged.

In the next few weeks I should receive the final copy of the recommendations from our External School Review. Some points to come from the review are:

Braeview has been improving its student achievement results over the past three years

There is a variety of high quality practice across the school. Students need to be involved more in the planning of the learning program  
Teachers need to be aware of how their work supports the work of the whole school  
Braeview needs to develop strategies to continually review the uptake of our site priorities

When the final report comes to the school it will be posted on our website so it is available for everyone to read. The final report will provide the school with a range of priorities it must pursue in its on-going improvement journey. Our next site review will be in 2022
