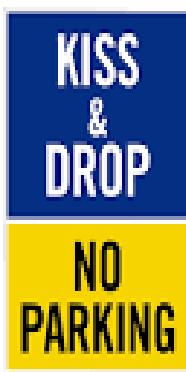

During Week 4 next term Braeview School will be having an External Site Review. The focus of the review will be to evaluate how well does our school improve student achievement, growth, challenge, engagement and equity. At the end of the review I will be given feedback regarding the school's effectiveness and will state future directions and implications for the school moving forward. As students will be interviewed by the panel can parents let me know in writing if you do not want your child to be available for interview, this can be placed in a student's diary or emailed to Sara in the Front Office.

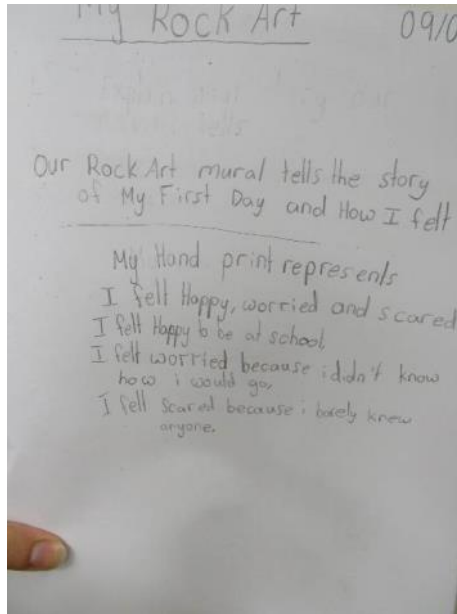
